It has certainly been a testing few weeks for our community. However, things are beginning to settle down and as you may already be aware, the government is preparing to move the nation to Alert Level 3 in the Covid - 19 response at some stage. However, at this time we are still in Alert Level 4.

The Prime Minister announced that our schools would be reopening shortly after we go into Alert Level 3 to children of essential workers and caregivers who will be required to return to work. She has stressed that precautions that have become the norm in recent weeks, including social distancing should remain in place.

As a result teachers will still be providing distant learning to students as well as supervising learning at school for the students whose parents meet the above criteria.
